ORDER:

1. Matriculation Schools affiliated to University of Madras and the Madurai University are fee-levying institutions. The medium of instruction in all of them is English. They do not receive any Government grant. They have created endowments stipulated by the respective University as well as the facilities for the various courses of study. The students therein appear for the Matriculation Examination conducted by the respective University.

2. On a suggestion from the syndicate of the University of Madras the question of transfer of the Matriculation Schools which are now affiliated to the University of Madras and Madurai University, to the Department of School Education has been engaging the attention of the Government for some time past. A meeting of the Managements of Matriculation Schools with the Government and the Madras University, was convened by the Vice-Chancellor of the University of Madras on 19.7.76. The following recommendations were made at that meeting:-

1) The Government be requested to set up a Board of Matriculation Schools, on which some Principals / Headmasters of the Schools, Educators, the University and the Department officials, be represented with the Board being responsible for the care and maintenance of the schools;
