ORDER:

In her letter read above, the Director of Matriculation School has stated that the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act 2009 contain various components like Admission of atleast 25% of children belonging to weaker/disadvantaged section, Admission procedure, compulsory admission, attendance and completion of Education, reimbursement of per child Expenditure for admission under 25%, conducting Teacher Eligibility Test banning corporal punishment inflicted on student, sensitisation of teachers in Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act and other academic activities.

2. She has also stated that Nodal Officer of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act 2009 Thiru.M.Palanisamy, Joint Director (Schemes), O/o State Council for Education Research and Training has discharged his duties as Nodal Officer and it is considered that one Nodal Officer may not be sufficient to monitor the effective implementation of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act 2009. Hence she has requested to appoint the Chief State Nodal officer in the Grade of "Director of School Education" with the following members to assist the Nodal Officer at State level.

1. Joint Director of School Education (Secondary)
2. Joint Director of Elementary Education (Aided)
3. Joint Director of Matriculation Schools

4. One Member from the cadre of Under Secretary to Government in the School Education Department
5. Law Officer from School Education Department

and has also requested to constitute District level Nodal Officer in the cadre of Chief Educational Officer with the following members to assist the Nodal Officer at district level.

1. Additional Chief Educational Officer (SSA) of the concerned District
2. District Educational officer
3. District Elementary Educational officer
4. Inspector of Matriculation Schools

3. She has also stated that the duties and responsibilities may be assigned to State and District Nodal Officer.

4. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Director of Matriculation schools and appoint the Director of Matriculation Schools as the Chief State Nodal Officer with the following members to assist the Nodal Officer at the State level.

1. Joint Director of School Education (Secondary)
2. Joint Director of Elementary Education (Aided)
3. Joint Director of Matriculation Schools
4. One Member from the cadre of Under Secretary to Government in the School Education Department.
5. Law Officer from School Education Department

and the Chief Educational Officer of the concerned district as nodal officer at District level with the following members to assist the Nodal Officer at District level to monitor the effective implementation of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act 2009.

- (i) Additional Chief Educational Officer (SSA) of the concerned District
- (ii) District Educational officer
- (iii) District Elementary Educational officer
- (iv) Inspector of Matriculation Schools

5. The following duties and responsibilities have assigned to the State and District Nodal Officer.

Chief State Nodal Officer	District Nodal Officer
To submit suitable proposals to Government as deemed to be fit in consultation with other Directors	To address all issues regarding Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act 2009 at district level.


To cause enquiry into any complaints regarding Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act 2009 through district committee and evolve suitable redressal mechanism.	To enquire all complaints regarding Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act 2009 and submit enquiry report to Chief State Nodal Officer.
To assist the State Council for Education, Research and Training and Other academic agencies in imparting Training to teachers and School Management Committee members.	To have effective coordination with the other agencies involved in the task of implementation of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act 2009
Any other issues that may arise from time to time.	To monitor the training programme of teachers/ School Management Committee members held at district level.
	To oversee whether all schools implement all the provision of RTE 2009 in this district.
